## Wynns The Banker Cabernet Sauvignon 2016

In the early 1920's, founder Samuel Wynn was saved from a ruthless property shark by the good nature of his bank manager who - without hesitation - rescued this struggling polish immigrant. Wynn never forgot his bank manager's support (based on kindness and not financial logic!) and remained loyal to his banker for the rest of his life.

Made in the traditional Wynns Cabernet Sauvignon style, this range of wine is named in the banker's honour.

A warm season with moderate yields delivering full fruit flavours and balanced acidity

**Harvest date** March 2016

**Peak duration** enjoy on release cellar carefully for up to 7 years

#### Maturation

This wine remained in tank to retain a fresh lift. Selected parcels received 12 months oak maturation with seasoned French oak barrels

#### Colour

Dark purple core

#### Nose

A classic Cabernet, bursting with plums, black raspberry, and briary tones. Subtle smoke and spice add a savoury element

#### Palate

Bursting with bright, juicy dark fruits and spicy oak touches. Rounded and seductive on the palate with a good tannic core that gives a nice grip on the finish. This is a satisfying bistro style wine, textured, flavour some and versatile
