How we Operate

GOVERNANCE

- Founded in 1961, the Geelong Business Club is the longest serving business association in Geelong. The Club is a notfor-profit incorporated body, run by a Committee of leading business professionals from the membership who volunteer their time.
- The Club employs an Executive Officer who coordinates the membership, the monthly Committee and Dinner meetings and supports the Committee of Management.

The Club's members meet once each month for a Club dinner, to meet, share experiences and listen to an externally invited guest speaker who is a leader in their field.

Dinner meetings are held on the second Monday of each month from February to December. *



MEMBERSHIP

- Membership is by nomination from existing members of at least one year standing in accordance with our Constitution.
- Membership is \$400 (+ GST) per financial year, charged annually in advance each July (and pro-rata upon commencement).
- A one-off joining fee of \$165 (+GST) applies as does a \$15 (+GST) Member Badge fee

DINNER MEETING ATTENDANCE

Members are required to attend as many of the 11 club dinners held each year as is possible.*

This is our members opportunity to join with other business professionals from our region while enjoying –

- Pre dinner drinks, meet and greet
- A gourmet two course dinner with waiter service
- Premium red and white wines with the meal
- Coffee and Cheeseboard
- A presentation by a guest speaker who is an expert in their field.

Members pay a club subsidised fee of \$75 per person (including GST) to attend each dinner.

Guests pay the full catering cost of \$85.00 per head.

- Women: appropriate business attire

INVITING GUESTS

Our Club is only as strong as its membership.

Members are encouraged to invite guests to Dinner Meetings to experience the Club and what it can offer them.
